mySurvey

Requirements:

- Server with PHP 5.0+ & Mysql 5.0+
- Windows, Linux or Unix

Features:

- Unlimited Questions
- Unlimited Answers
- Unlimited Surveys
- Admin Panel
- Realtime Statistics
- View Statistics by survey and questions and export to csv
- 8 Questions types with template that allows variety of answers
- Custom question types + custom template (Developers)
- Survey Themes (1 Responsive theme Included)
- Fully Customizable theme
- Ability to create a survey in your language
- One click install

Description:

mySurvey is a php and ajax system that allows you to run and create your own surveys faster and easier with ability to customize the questions, answers, the theme and the surveys. There are 3 easy steps to publish a survey: create a survey, add questions and answers and publish the survey.

mySurvey supports creation of: multiple choice questions, rank order questions, rating scale questions, open ended questions, close ended questions with the questions types.

Setup

Preparing files:

1. Unzip the download package to somewhere on your hard drive;
2. Using the software's your hosting provides, upload the files from the "mySurvey" directory to your server root directory sometimes called "www" or "public_html" or "html" or "website_html" or "htdocs";
3. Access the website and with the one click install feature install it. If for some reason you have serious trouble installing I have placed sample connection file 'connection.sample.php' for you to fill it with your server setting and a sample sql in the folder 'SQL' and using a tool your hosting provides (phpmyadmin) upload the file your server or copy the contents and run the query on your server.

Author Notes

If you published a survey and you are getting errors such as "bad survey" it's because your survey was wrong created. To fix this issue you must add an answer to the questions. It can't just happen to have questions without answers for users to respond!

Importing a themes & Creating Themes

To import a theme using server upload tools, upload the created theme to the folder theme. On the folder 'includes' there will be a php file named 'themes.php' open that file and add to the array the name of your theme.
