THEME INSTALATION

Theme Instalation Using FTP Client

1. Unzip the download package using Winzip or equivalent.
2. You will see another zip archive file inside called `cristiano.theme.zip`, unzip this file also using Winzip or equivalent software and using an FTP client (eg. [FileZilla](#)), upload its contents to your WordPress installation. You will need to place the folder into the following location: `wp-content/themes`
3. Now inside your WordPress admin area, go to **Appearance > Themes** and there you will see the **Cristiano** Theme.
4. Click **Activate** to activate the theme. If you do not see the theme in this screen, you have done something incorrectly. Review the last few steps again.

Theme Instalation From Admin Panel

1. Unzip the **Cristiano** download package. Once unzipped you will see a zip file named `cristiano.theme.zip`, this is a compressed version of the theme.
2. Now inside your WordPress admin area, go to **Appearance > Themes > Add new > Upload theme**
3. Click browse and locate this `cristiano.theme.zip` file and upload it
4. Now you will see the **Cristiano** theme in the **Themes** page.
5. Click **Activate** to activate the theme. If you do not see the theme in this screen, you have done something incorrectly. Review the last few steps again.

After install theme, you will need to install and active some plugins, just click **Begin installing plugins** and active it.

Do not upload the Themeforest download package directly to your WordPress site, because this will lead to errors. Make sure to Unzip this package and inside you will find the theme zip archive: `cristiano.theme.zip`. This is what you will need to upload to your WordPress installation.

This theme requires the following plugins: *Cristiano Dishes Menu*, *Cristiano Promo Slider*, *Cristiano Shortcodes* and [WooCommerce](#).

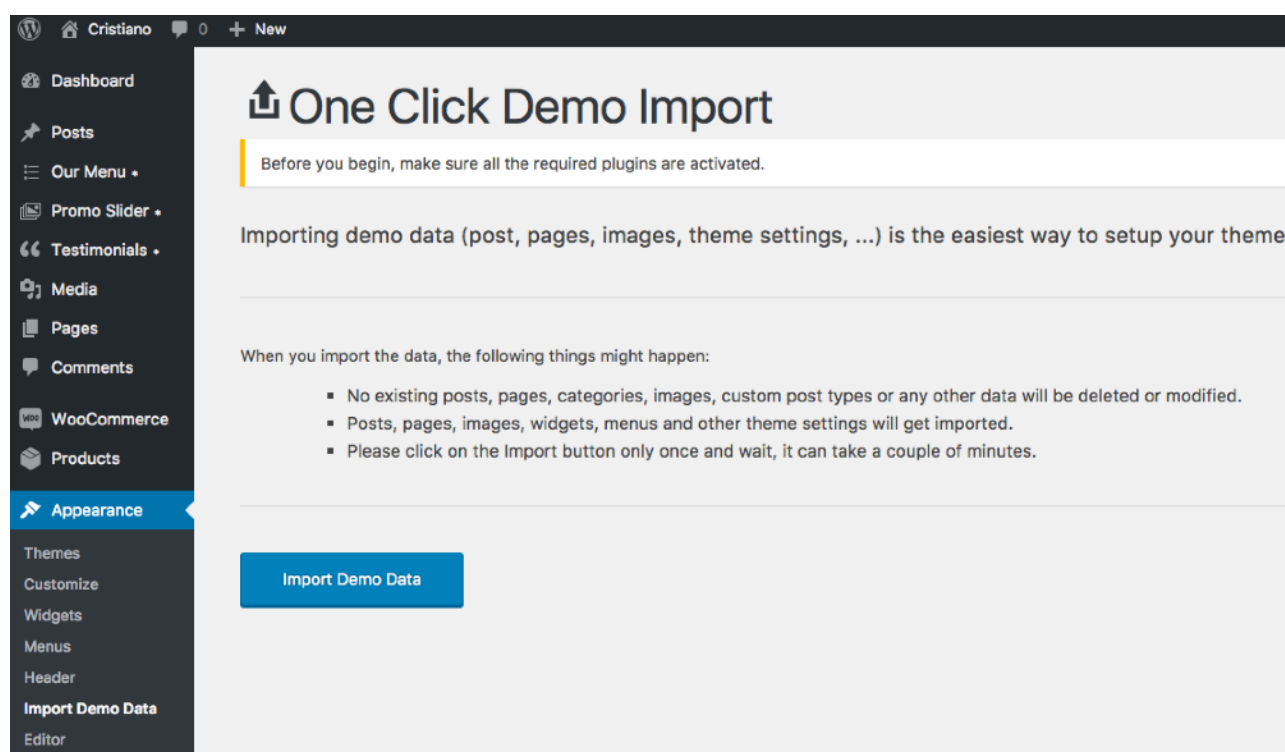

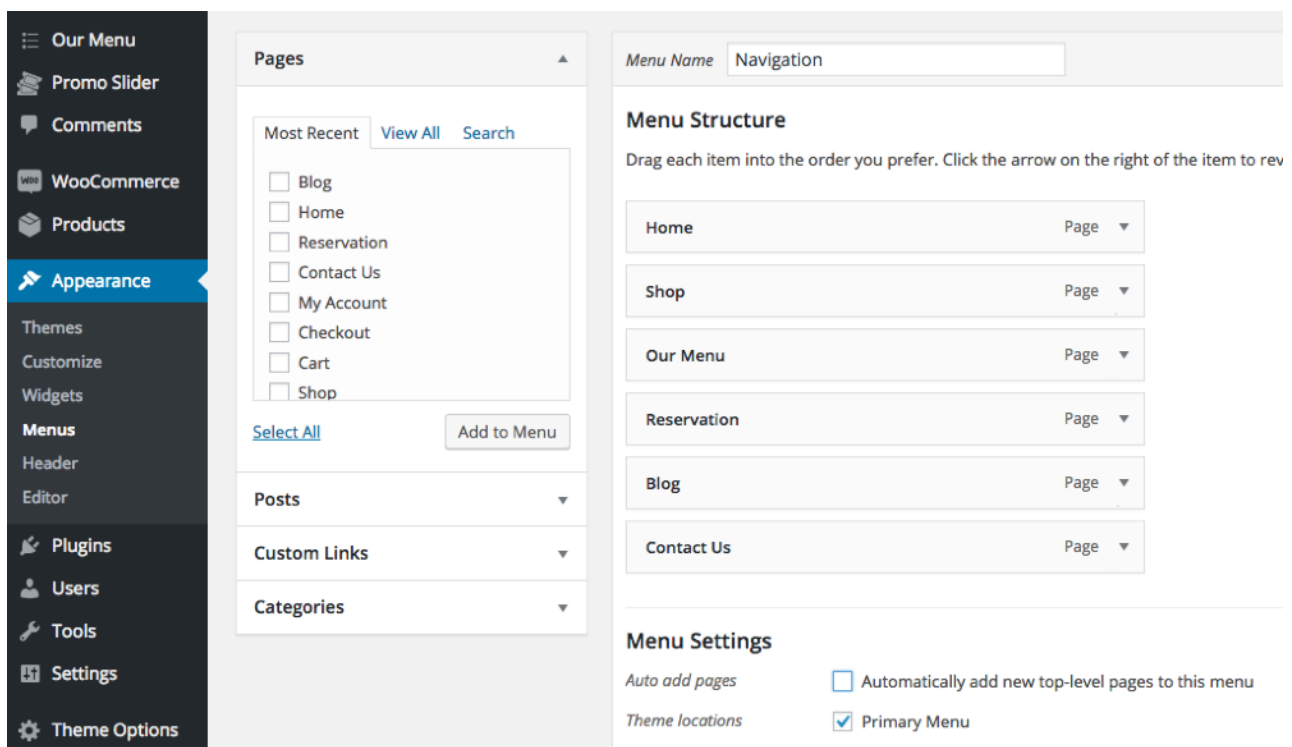

CREATING MENU


1. Go to **Appearance** → **Menus** in the main admin menu.
2. At first you will probably need to add a menu, give it a name & click **Create Menu**.
The new menu will appear in a tab in this location. Click on this tab to begin adding menu items.
3. Use the dialog boxes on the left hand side of the page to add items to your menu. Select the master page you created as well as all of the sub sections or child pages and click "Add to Menu".
4. Now you can drag the newly inserted menu item to their correct sequence and rename their titles if required.
5. Choose **Theme locations - Primary Menu** in Menu Settings
6. After you have added and edited the menu items click **Save Menu** button in the bottom of this area.



THEME CUSTOMIZER

Adding your Site logo

1. Open Appearance → Customize and click on the **Site Identity** section.

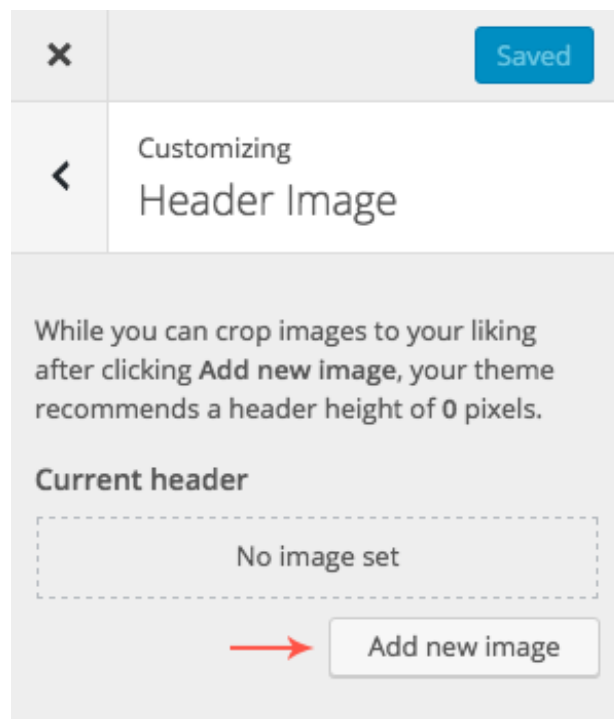

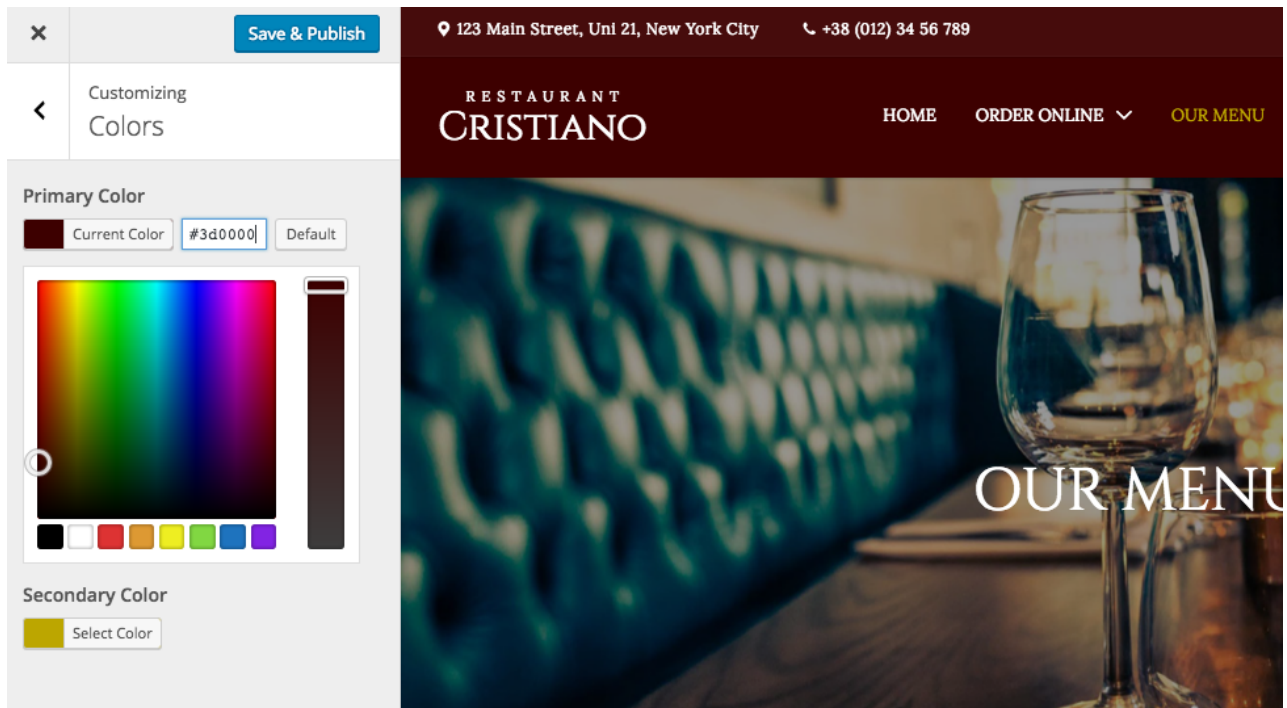
Header Image will be shown in all pages except Home Page.

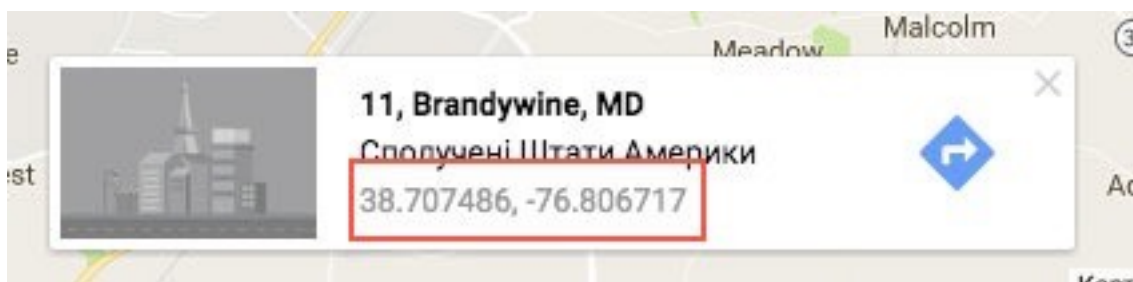

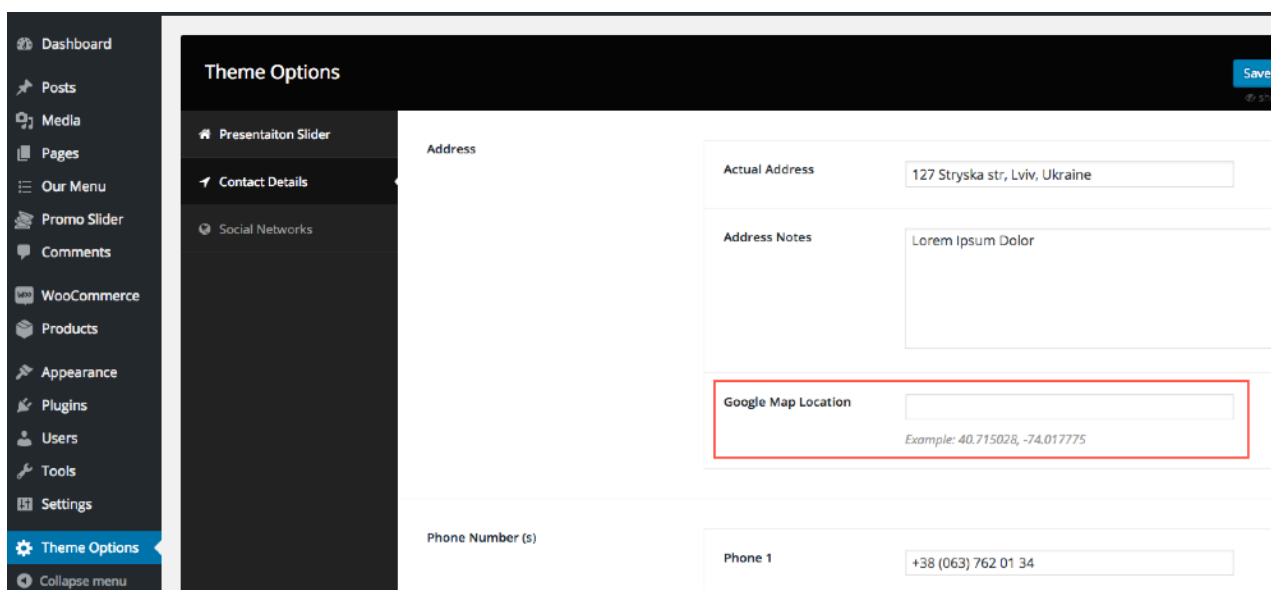

on your site dashboard **Pages > Add new**, and title your new page “Home.” Be sure to publish this page.

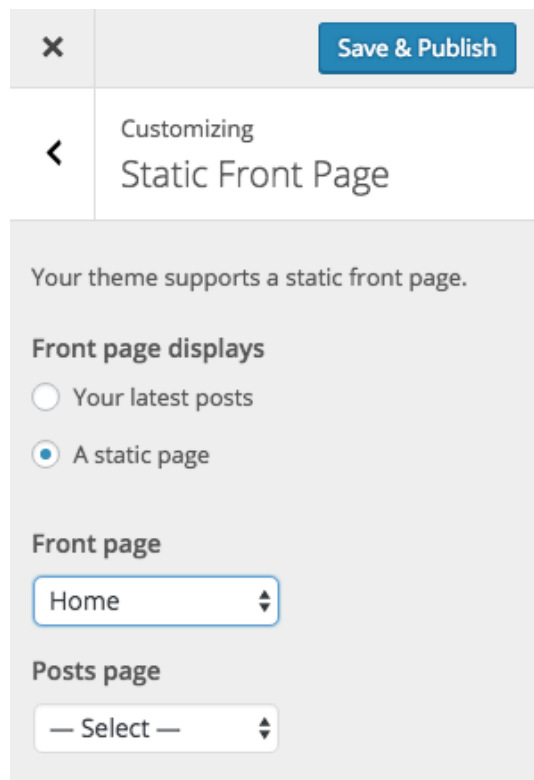
2. Set a Static Front Page

The preview window will display your newly selected page as the front page of your site.

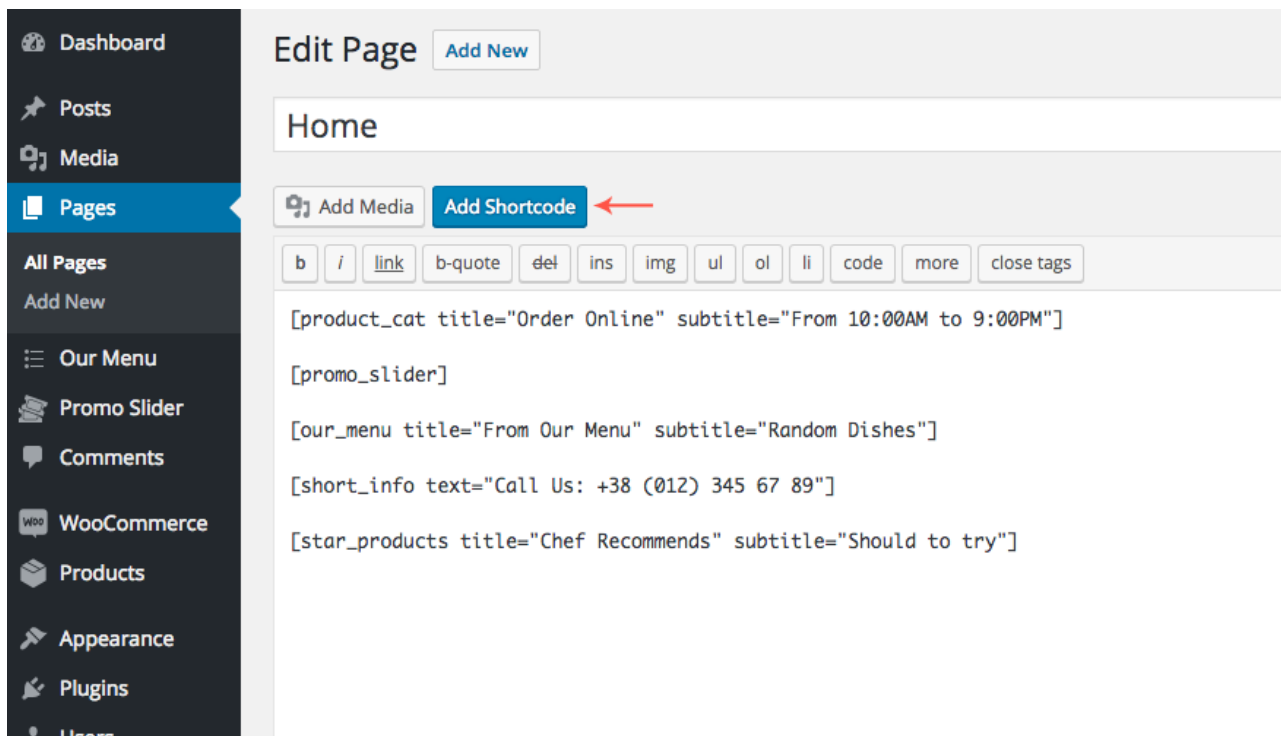
3. Click on the **Save & Publish** button to save your static page settings.



The Content in Home Page Generated by Shortcodes.

A shortcode is a WordPress-specific code that lets you do nifty things with very little effort. Shortcodes can embed files or create objects that would normally require lots of complicated, ugly code in just one line. Shortcode = shortcut.

You can write shortcode manually or generate it by **Add Shortcode** Button.

On the Edit Gallery page, you can do the following things before inserting the gallery you have created into your page or post:

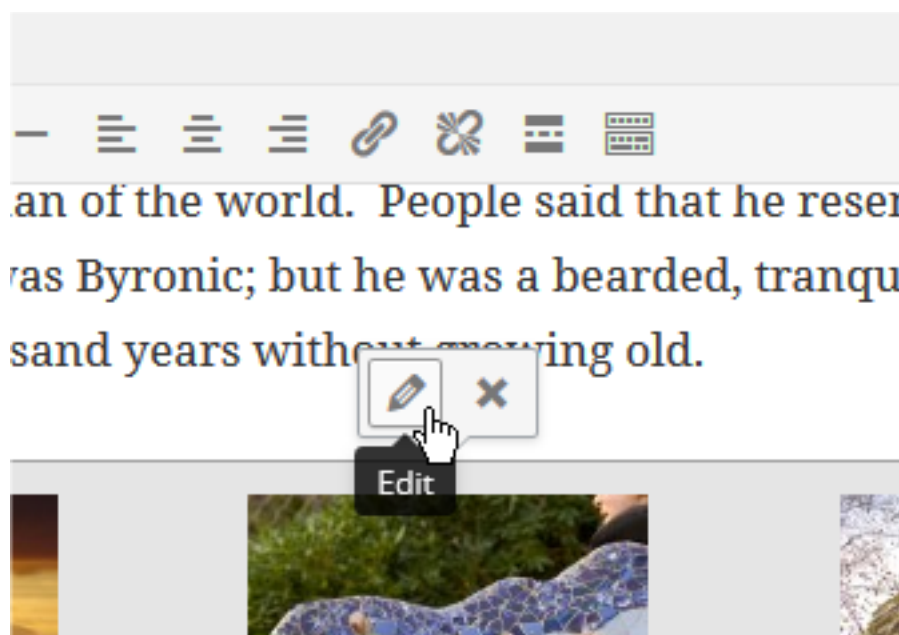
Rearrange your images: Drag and Drop image thumbnails to rearrange the order of images in your gallery.

Translation Using PO File

To translate the theme using the POT file do the following

1. Create a po file for your language, for example de_DE.po
2. Copy all text from provided theme pot file into your po file
3. Edit the po file with code <http://www.poedit.net/>
4. Create the mo file
5. edit *wp-config.php* file in your installation and set **WPLANG** so it matches your languages: **define('WPLANG', 'de_DE');**
6. The Theme should now display all messages in your language.

BACKUP YOUR LANGUAGE PO/MO FILES Upon theme update, language files are **NOT** preserved. You will need to manually restore your po/mo files right after the update.
