We would like to thank you for choosing Nørebro WordPress Theme and we will be very happy to help you get familiar with Nørebro's features very quickly. We love to help our customers as well as listen to their suggestions to make our products better. Nørebro is a WordPress theme so we assume that you have already installed WordPress.

To use Nørebro you need to have a server that meets the following requirements:

- WordPress version 4.3 or higher
- PHP version 5.5 or higher

- MySQL version 5 or higher

PHP settings:

- memory_limit – 128M
- max_execution_time – 180
- max_input_time – 60
- upload_max_filesize – 32M

That's really it. We recommend [Apache](#) or [Nginx](#) as the most robust and featureful servers for running WordPress, but any server that supports PHP and MySQL should work.

Download Nørebro WordPress Theme files from ThemeForest by going to the Downloads tab and finding Nørebro Theme. Click on the Download button, Main Files contain everything and the Installable WordPress file only is just the installable WordPress theme file. Below is the full list of what files are included in the downloaded Main Files.

Nørebro Theme Folder – it contains the norebro.zip and norebro-child.zip WordPress theme. The child

theme is only for users who make code changes in Norebro theme.

Documentation Folder – it contains the documentation for the Norebro theme.

Common Questions

q: If I need to use Nørebro for a second site, do I need a second license?

a: Yes. One purchase of Nørebro allows you to use the theme for one finished site. If you need to use it for a second site, you are supposed to purchase a second license.

q: Can I use Nørebro for a test site, then move it to the live site when finished?

a: Yes, you can. You can use the theme for a test site to build it, then move it to the live site once you're finished.

q: May I keep a test site and the live site online at the same time with one Regular License purchase?

a: According to the licensing rules set by Envato, this is not allowed. If you are using it for two projects at the same time, then you are supposed to have two licenses.

There are a few premium plugins bundled with Nørebro that do not require any additional licensing in order to be used with Nørebro.

Common Questions

q: I see messages asking me to enter a license key to activate the Visual Composer and Revolution Slider plugins

a: In fact, these plugins require a license key to activate the automatic update feature. Once you've activated them in the Plugins menu, they are fully ready to use. You may ignore those messages.

q: How do I update the premium plugins?

a: Nørebro does include updates for our premium plugins (Revolution Slider, Visual Composer, ACF PRO). However, this does not mean that you will receive individual licenses for these premium plugins. Due to Envato's licensing rules, we can only issue updates for these plugins when we publish a theme update. This also serves as proof that we've fully tested the plugin, which means that its new version will not conflict with the latest version of our theme.

Theme Installation


Nørebro can be installed in two ways: Installing through WordPress or Uploading through FTP (File Transfer Protocol).

Installing through WordPress:

- Navigate to *Appearance > Themes*
- Click the [Add New](#) button at the top of the page, then the [Upload Theme](#) button

– Click **Choose File** and find the theme files you've just downloaded. If you downloaded the installable WordPress file, then you do not need to unzip the file. If you downloaded the Full Theme Package, you need to unzip the master norebro.zip file inside which you will see a secondary norebro.zip file; this is the one you need to install.

If you have a theme in a .zip format, you may install it by uploading it here.

- Click the **Install Now** button
- After installing click **Activate**, or go to *Appearance > Themes* and activate the Nørebro theme

If you fail to install the theme using the WordPress install function, we recommend using FTP:

- If you downloaded the Full Theme Package from ThemeForest, please unzip the package file to get the theme file norebro.zip. Unzip the norebro.zip file, you'll have a folder called norebro in there
 - Use a FTP client like [FileZilla](#) and upload the extracted folder to *wp-content/themes* folder on your host
 - Log in to your WordPress Dashboard and navigate to *Appearance > Themes* and click the [Activate](#) button of the Nørebro theme

Nørebro uses 8 plugins (Nørebro Extra, Visual Composer, Contact Form 7, Slider Revolution, ACF PRO, One Click Demo, Envato Tools) that will need to be installed & activated. Nørebro Extra, ACF PRO and Visual Composer plugins are required for the theme to work. Other 5 plugins are recommended plugins as per the features of theme you want to use (demo installation, portfolio support, auto-update, etc).

Demo Installation

To install a demo on your site, do the following:

- Make sure that Nørebro is installed and activated
 - Install all the needed and recommended plugins (at the top of the page there will be a message with all the links)
 - Go to *Dashboards > Appearance > Import Demo*
 - Choose the demo you want to install, click on the **Import** button below it
 - WordPress will download all content that it needs for the demo, then you will get a message saying that everything has been installed
 - The demo page will be set as your Front Page. If you want to change this, go to Settings > Reading and there you can set another Front Page

Automatically Update

You don't have to download this plugin since it is included in our theme.

– Choose the Envato Market plugin in the *Plugins > Installed Plugins* menu and choose the option *Activate*, press **Apply**. Now you need to generate an Envato API token.

– Go to <https://build.envato.com/create-token/>

– Give your token a name, agree to the terms and click on the **Create Token** button.

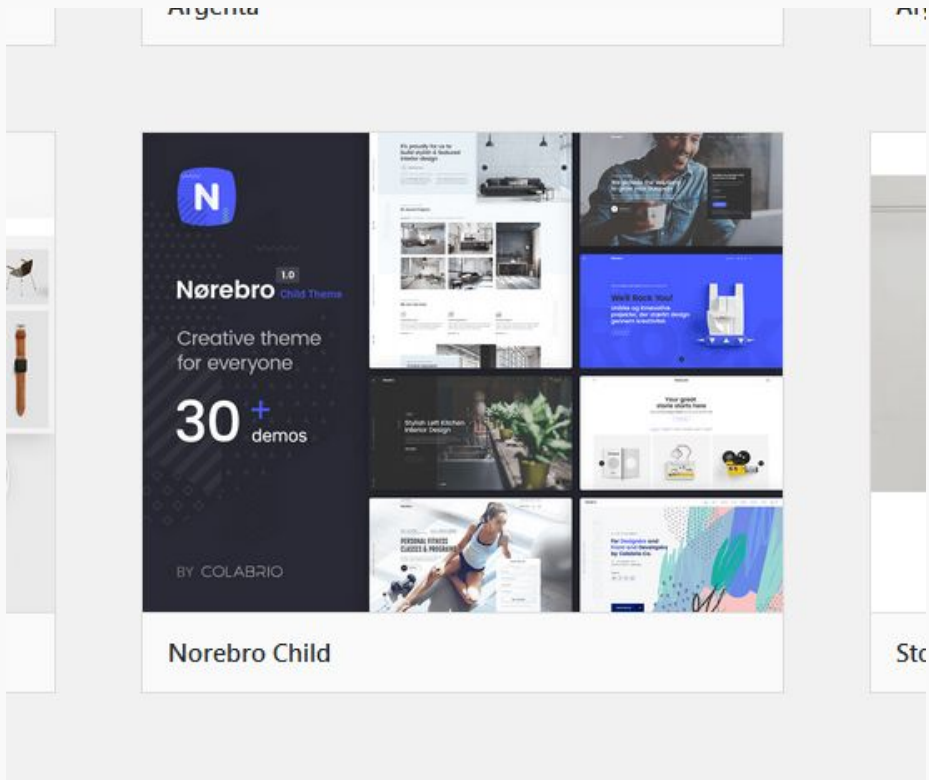
– Copy the token, go to your WordPress dashboard, click on Envato Market in the menu, paste your token in the Token line.

– Click on **Save Changes**.

Congratulations! Now that you have Envato Market plugin, you can go to *Appearance > Themes* and see if there is an update for your themes.

Child Theme

A Child Theme is a theme that inherits the functionality and styling of another theme, called the parent theme. Child themes are the recommended way of modifying an existing theme.



What is the point of using a Child Theme?

- If you modify a theme directly and it is updated, then your modifications may be lost. By using a child theme you will ensure that your modifications are preserved.
- Using a child theme can speed up development time.
- Using a child theme is a great way to learn about WordPress theme development.

How does it work?

A WordPress theme usually consists of a number of files stored in a folder. Two of those files are mandatory:

The first one is *functions.php*, it is used to define functions, classes, actions and filters to be used by other templates in the theme. It can be used to add features and extend the functionality of both the theme, and the WordPress installation.

The second one is *style.css*, it stores meta-information and styles.

Both of them have to be present in your site root directory, in order for the site to work.

So, the Nørebro Child Theme metafile has the following directive activated: “*Parent: norebro*”, which makes your WordPress use the Nørebro theme files, except the above mentioned ones.

Now you have everything that the theme has to offer, but you use your own *functions.php* and *style.css* and those don’t get replaced after an update, which means you never lose your changes.

To make a change to the Child Theme, you need to replace your child theme file with the same one from the parent theme.

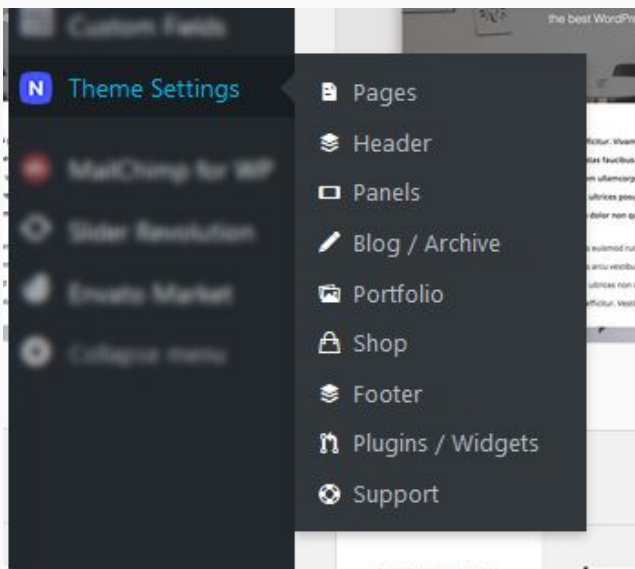
There’s the thing: you may edit any file except demo files and settings files, so changing them is pointless, they will get replaced after an update and you will lose your changes.

Theme Settings

Settings in Nørebro work on one simple principle:

Options affecting all pages are global, other - local.

In addition, often global settings are called *theme settings*. When you want to get a customization from global configuration of the site, you will see the Theme Settings Inherited option. This means that the value will be taken from global settings. All global settings can be found in *Dashboard > Theme Settings*. In addition, you can customize differently all pages of the blog, regular pages and shop pages. In any case, if there is no setting value for any page, the global page setup will be taken. You can set all the pages in one setting and change a few others. It's easy.



If you want to customize a particular page, you should use the local page settings. These settings have a *simple page*, a *portfolio page*, a *post* and a *product page*. In addition, there are some settings for page templates.

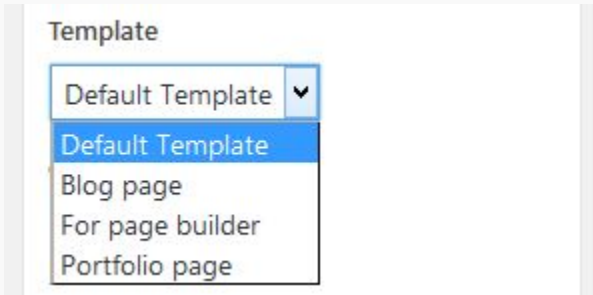

Page Templates

The theme contains three custom page templates:



- *Blog page.* This template show a blog with the latest posts and allows you to customize the posts/grid/page as you need. The fact is that WordPress doesn't allow you to edit a blog as a page, so this is the best solution for quickly creating your blog in one click.
- *For page builder.* This is a clean page without a sidebar and header title, which is great for creating custom pages and single-page sites. Use this template for your landings or universal pages.
- *Portfolio page.* Allows you to quickly create a page with your portfolio of projects and customize styles as you need it. In fact, this is a page with a built-in “Recent Projects” shortcode feature. If you need more

functionality, we recommend using a blank page with a shortcode. This template is a quick and easy solution.

Translations of the Theme

Our theme fully supports WPML. This means that you can translate your site to any language and most of the settings of the plugin will work correctly with our theme. Unfortunately, this plugin doesn't come with the theme, but if you need to understand how the plugin works, you can see it [here](#).

You can also do the translation without this plugin. Main language file "*norebro.po*" is located in a "*languages*" folder in the main theme folder. To translate the theme, follow these basic steps:

- Download, install and open [Poedit](#)
- Navigate to *File > New Catalog from POT file*
- Open "*wp-content/themes/norebro/languages/norebro.po*" file
- Fill in the *Catalog properties* (optional)

- Save as file named by theme name *norebro* and *your language and country code* ("norebro-fr_FR.po", "norebro-cs_CZ.po", "norebro-de_DE.po", etc.) into to the "*wp-content/languages/themes*" folder (if the folder does not exist, please create it)
