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1. Online Documentation

This theme comes with extended Online Documentation, where you can find multiple articles about how to install & use this theme, and the answers for popular questions. Online Documentation will be regularly updated so you might want to check it from time to time.

2. What's included with Theme

This theme comes with bundled premium plugins – [WPBakery Page Builder](#) (formerly: Visual Composer), and [Revolution Slider](#). Both plugins are included with this theme, and you don't need to purchase separated licenses for this plugins, unless you want to get your personal copy or need any extra feature offered by this plugins.

Once theme is installed and activated, you can go to “Appearance” – “Install Plugins” in your WordPress admin panel, to install all bundled and/or recommended plugins easily.

Downloading all theme files or installable files only

After theme purchase, go to “Downloads” tab on ThemeForest (you must be logged in) and find Ueldo WordPress theme on your purchases list. On your right-hand side, you'll find green “Download” button – when you'll click on it, dropdown list will appear with this two options inside:

- **All files & documentation**
Choose this option to download all theme files, child theme files, documentation and license details.
- **Installable WordPress file only**
Choose this option to get only installable theme files, packed in “ueldo.zip” file. This file can be used to [install Ueldo WordPress theme](#) through your WordPress admin panel.

Demo contents

Ueldo WordPress theme uses free and **stock images** that are **NOT included** in the download package – those images are used for demo purposes only. Flaticon icons also are not included to theme, but can be downloaded for free from Flaticon's website and easily uploaded to your new website with [Ueldo Icons Uploader](#) tool.

This theme comes with multiple demo templates built-in with this theme, and you can install it easily following [this instruction](#). With the Ueldo WordPress theme you can install all the layouts and pages you see in the demo sites – you can get an exact replica of the demo sites, just without images and Flaticon icons.

3. Server Requirements

To run Ueldo WordPress theme without any problems, we strongly recommend you to use always the latest available WordPress version (at least 4.9), PHP version 5.3 or greater, and MySQL 5 or higher. Using always latest WordPress version is important to make sure that all theme features & functionalities will work correctly, and that your website is safe.

PHP requirements

PHP contains many settings variables, which can be modified by your server administrators (less often you'll have access to php.ini to change those variables by yourself). There are few PHP variables which are the most important for Ueldo WordPress theme, like:

- **max_input_vars**
At least 8192 for multilingual websites, or at least 2048 for non-multilingual websites
- **memory_limit**
Memory limit variable value shouldn't be less than 256M.
- **upload_max_filesize**
Server upload max. file size variable value shouldn't be less than 32M.

System requirements

Check here if your server meets all theme requirements - this is important to have all features working correctly.

Check here if your server meets all theme requirements - this is important to have all features working correctly.

For demo templates installation, theme requires also that WordPress uploads folder is writable (this means that “wp-content/uploads” directory uses correct “chmod” value), and that your WordPress configuration allows the ZIP files upload (this can be changed in “Settings” – “General” tab in your WordPress admin panel).

OpenSSL available

If you want to use the Import / Export or Restore Theme Options feature, then you should enable OpenSSL library on your server. If it's not available, please contact with your server administrators.

4. Theme Installation

You can install Ueldo WordPress theme on two ways: through your WordPress admin panel, or via FTP – the most simple and intuitive is the first option.

1. Install through WordPress admin panel

Follow this few simple steps to install Ueldo theme on your website:

- Go to “Appearance” – “Themes” (you must be logged in with administrator role on your WordPress admin panel),
- Click “Install themes” and click on “Upload” button,
- Find the “ueldo.zip” theme installation file on your computer and click on “Install now” button.

2. Install through FTP

If there are some upload limits on your server or installation through WordPress admin panel failed for some reason, you might need to install this theme via FTP.

Please follow this steps to proceed it correctly:

- Connect with your FTP server via FileZilla (<https://filezilla-project.org/>) or any other FTP client,
- Browse to “wp-content/themes” directory in WordPress directory tree on your FTP server,
- Unzip “ueldo.zip” installable WordPress file on your local computer and upload extracted “ueldo” directory to your FTP server.

Theme Activation after installation

After correct theme installation you should activate it in “Appearance” – “Themes” page. Find Ueldo WordPress theme on your themes list and click on “Activate” button. That’s it!

5. Install Required Plugins

This theme requires two plugins which are bundled with it – **Ueldo Plugin** and **WPBakery Page Builder** (formerly: Visual Composer). Go to “Appearance” – “Install Plugins” to install all required plugins and consider installation of other recommended plugins (which might be required if you’ll install any of the demo templates).

When you’ll install the Ueldo Plugin you’ll be able to find the “Ueldo” menu element on your WordPress admin panel, and click on “Ueldo” – “Dashboard” to make sure that your server & WordPress configuration meets all theme requirements.

6. Upload custom icons

FlatIcon is one of the most amazing icons library in the world – 650.000+ icons base designed with different, multiple styles, and grouped with collections, can be a wonderful addition to your website.

Ueldo WordPress theme contains built-in tool which will allows you to use any icon from this powerful library on your website just with few clicks.


Step 1. Pick your icons collection and download it as iconfont

Go to FlatIcon website and find icons you want to use on your website. Add those icons to collection, and once it's done, click on "Download collection" button. You'll see few options there – choose "Iconfont" and proceed the download.

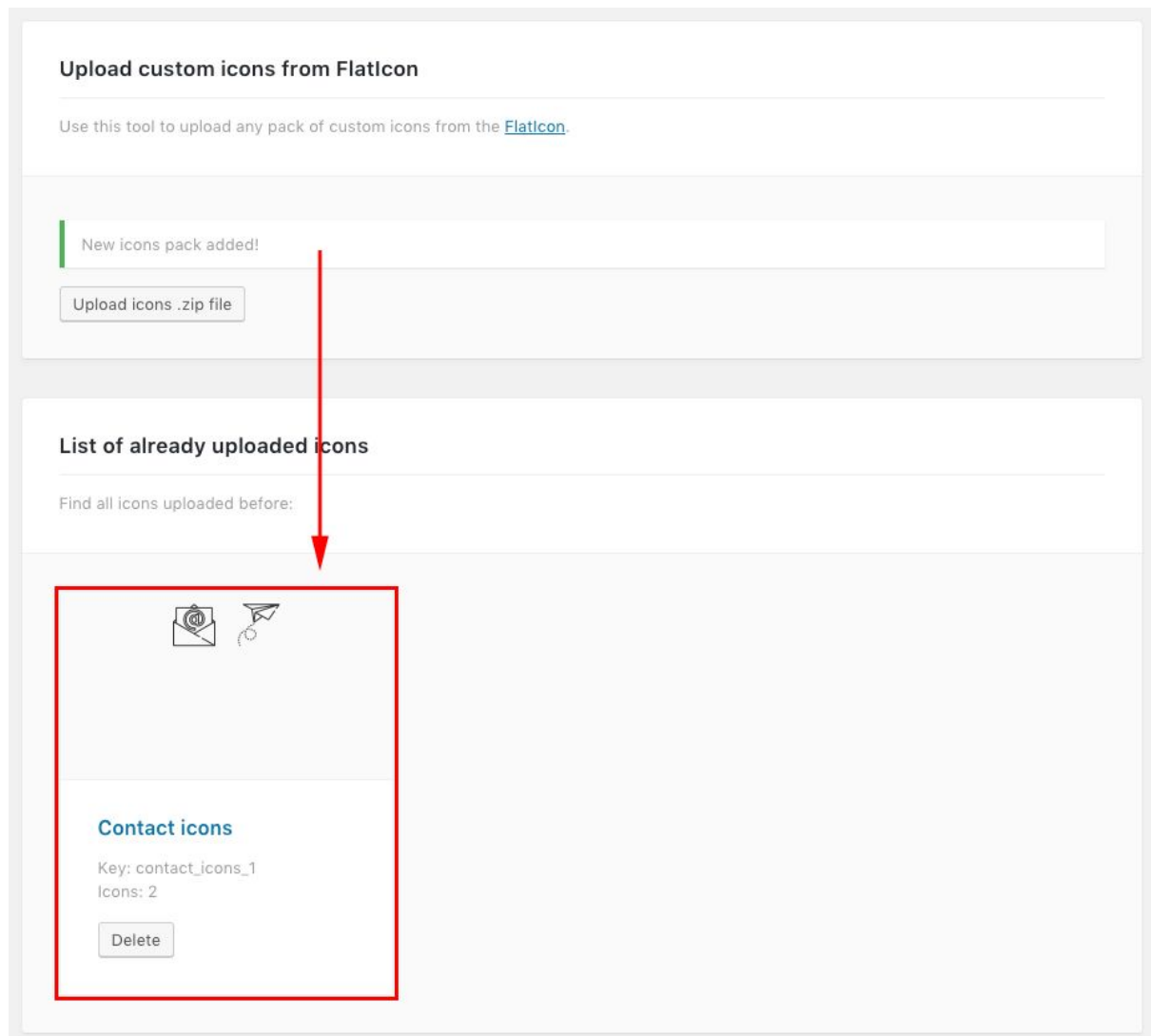
Step 2. Upload iconfont to Ueldo Icons Uploader tool

Go to "Ueldo" – "Add Custom Icons" page in your WordPress admin panel, and click on "Upload icons .zip file". Upload your iconfont library there, set your iconfont name and click on "Add icons" button.

Step 3. Use icons on your website!

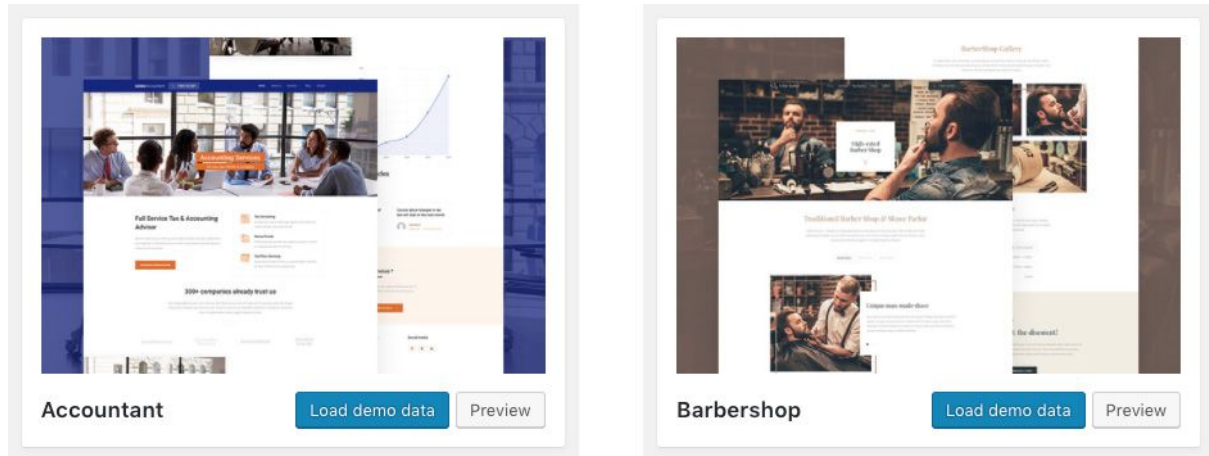
That's all! You can use this icons on your website now, without any extra coding or other changes. You can change icons colors & sizes separately in different places, just with Ueldo WordPress theme shortcodes in page builder.

7. Install Demo Template

When Ueldo WordPress theme is installed & activated on your WordPress, and also Martanian Ueldo Plugin is installed, you can go to “Ueldo” – “Load demo data” page and install any demo template you want.



Ueldo WordPress theme comes with built-in templates which can be used for any website. You can choose between different types of templates to fit it to your own needs, and create new website which will delight your customers.

Follow this few simple steps to install any selected demo template on your website:

1. go to “Ueldo” – “Load demo data” page in your WordPress admin panel,
2. choose demo template you want to install (you can click on “Preview” button to check how it looks on main demo preview) and click on blue “Load demo data” button.

Demo template installation popup will appear – follow instructions which will be displayed there to proceed the installation. That’s all! After installation, you can preview your new website or start editing it.

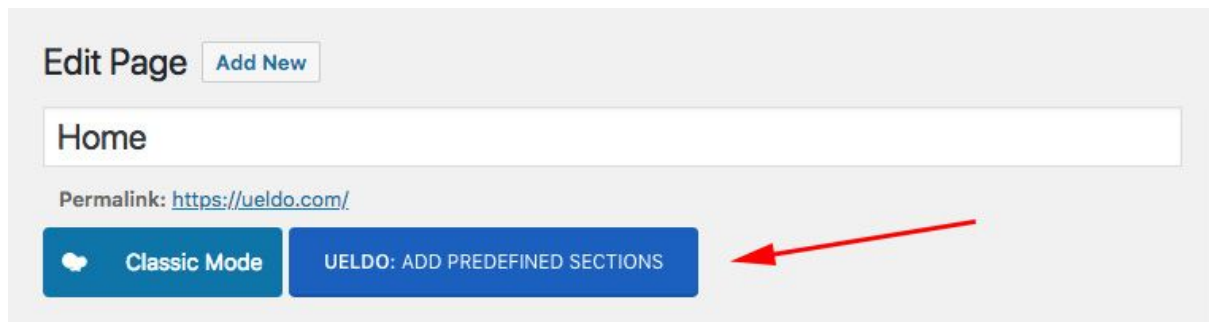

8. Composing Pages

Ueldo WordPress theme comes with WPBakery Page Builder plugin and custom Predefined Sections Popup tool, dedicated for this theme only.

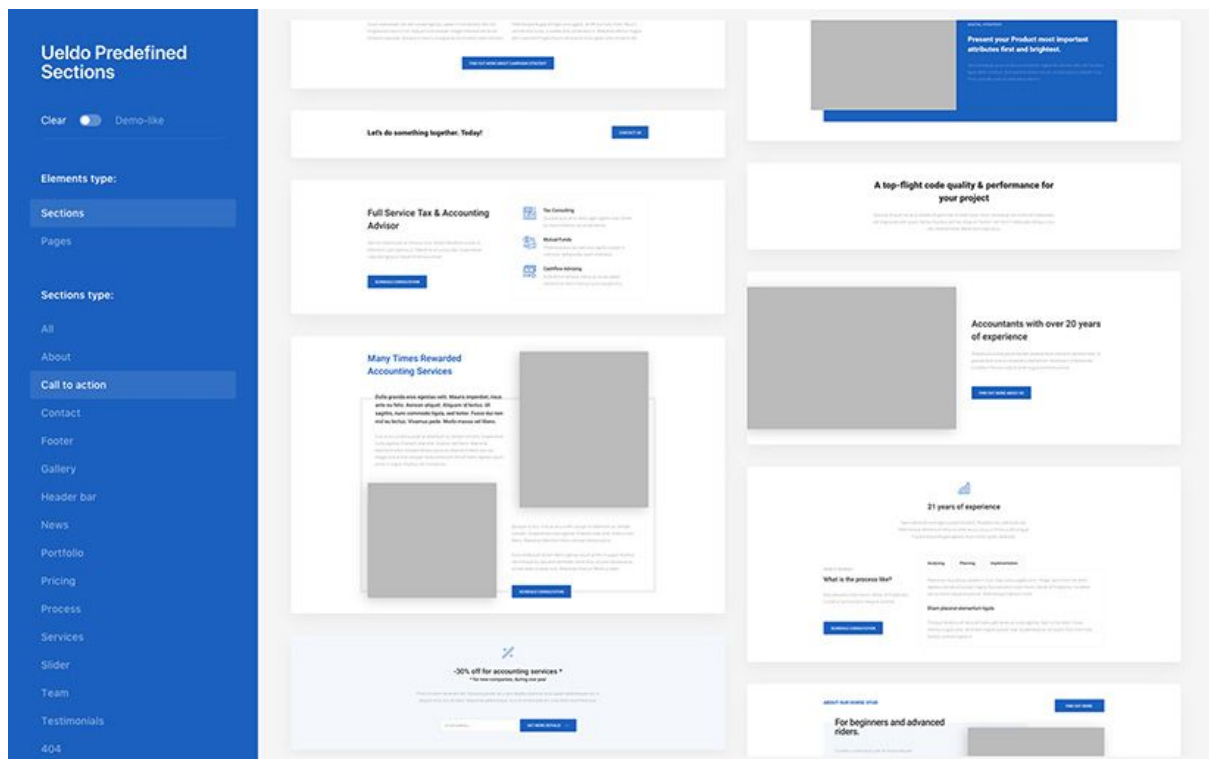
How to open Predefined Sections popup?

Simply go to selected page editor and click on blue button: “Ueldo: Add Predefined Sections”, right under the page title field:



Filter sections & pages

You can filter sections & pages available in Predefined Sections popup, to find the one you're looking for, using filters available on your left hand side (on blue background):



Sections are loaded per 15 to avoid lacks, so you might need to scroll down the sections list and click on “Load more...” button to load next pack of 15 sections or pages.

Difference between “clear” and “demo-like” option

At the top right side of Predefined Sections popup, you can find selector between “clear” and “demo-like” value. This define if selected section or page code, which will be added to your website, will contain colors & other specific settings dedicated for its original demo template, or for default theme options.

- **Clear**
Load “clear” sections without extra settings for colors (recommended if you want to use section from different demo version than the one you already use).
- **Demo-like**
Load “demo-like” sections with extra settings for sizes and colors (recommended if you want to use section from the same demo version than the one you already use).

How to add selected section to my page?

Just click on selected section – that’s all! Everything else will be processed automatically.

Clarification popup

Sometimes, after click on selected section you might see the “Clarification popup”. It shows up when selected section contains some elements which are not explicit for Predefined Sections uploader. You’ll see a short list of simple clarification questions, like:

- which icon should be used instead the one which couldn’t be found,
- which icon should be used, if there are more than one icon found in library with the same or similar name,
- which Google map, Opening hours set, Contact Form etc. should be added to selected section (if section contains one of this elements)

This require only few more clicks on your side (one at least), but could save your time while composing your pages. You wouldn’t need to find elements added incorrectly and replace them manually, if you’ll made proper choices in clarification popup.
